#### HANDICAP UPDATE

The NIMAGA Board of Directors decided to use the WHS/CDGA Handicap Service and suspended the use of the NIMAGA Tournament Handicap for the 2021 season.

Now that NIMAGA has transitioned to a handicap service that uses the World Handicap System, your handicap index is updated nightly. NIMAGA has established revision dates that NIMAGA will use to identify your current handicap index for the upcoming tournament and the minimum number of scores that must be reported for that tournament.

Reminder to All Members. If a member does not report all of his properly adjusted golf scores (excluding scores that NIMAGA submits) to the handicapping service on a timely basis, he may be subject to penalties. The form of the penalty is at the discretion of the Board of Directors and may consist of expulsion from NIMAGA or loss of privileges to compete in NIMAGA tournaments. Neither NIMAGA nor the CDGA will certify a member's handicap index unless it is based on current scores. Members should periodically review their handicap index posted on the CDGA website to be certain all their scores have been received and properly reported.

## **GOLF GENIUS UPDATE**

As we head into April, we are well into our Golf Genius undertaking. Membership registration is going smoothly as well as tournament registrations. To date, we have over 130 members who have registered with NIMAGA and over 310 players registered into our tournaments all by using this new software. We have had a few minor issues along the way, but you have to break a few eggs to make an omelet. All in all, the process has been widely accepted among the membership and the Board appreciates that.

Another Golf Genius milestone will come with our first tournament, the Spring Thaw on April 10<sup>th</sup> and we will have a few tweaks to our tournaments that you need to be aware of.

- Once the pairings are finalized, the tee sheet will be emailed out to the players. This will occur a week prior to the tournament.
- The tee sheet will contain:
  - o Times & pairings
  - Golf Genius scoring procedures
  - Skins collection with Venmo information (but we will take skins at the course).
  - Pace of play rules
- Prior to the tournament, you all should download the Golf Genius mobile app on your smart phones. Just search your app store for 'Golf Genius' and download (it is a free app).
- On the day of the tournament, you will be given a Golf Genius card prior to your foursome teeing off.
  - On side of the card will be your Division, Tee Time, and a Golf Genius ID (GGID)
  - $\circ$   $\,$  On the Other side of the card will be these instructions:

Pick one player in your group to enter scores in the Golf Genius app by logging in with the GGID.

Each player keeps score on their scorecard for the group.

After the round, fill out the whitecard, verify the scores and sign the whitecard.

Turn in the whitecard to the TD (who will verify and/or post scores in Golf Genius).

We have had several members and board directors use Golf Genius on the golf course and test things out. We are confident that you will find this easy to use and will not impact your pace of play. Additionally, you can see where you stand throughout the round and see the leaderboard when you finish your round.

While these may seem like of a lot of changes, it will all become second nature after a few tournaments.

Just another thanks to all of you for your patience and acceptance of our new policies and practices. The Board is confident that these changes will make your NIMAGA Golf experience better.
