

Rules Sheet – May Jamboree

Bartlett Hills GC – Saturday May 1, 2021

Palmer – Blue Tees



Closest to the Pin – 11 & 18

Bunkers are all Lift, Smooth/Rake (If Present) & Place

No stakes or lines marking penalty areas / OB, so:

- #1 OB on right side (Driving Range)
- #8 Entire right side of hole plays as penalty area NOT OB
- #9 Right side OB (Fence) / Stream Left - Penalty Area
- #10 OB left side (Driving Range)
- #12 OB left side (Fence)
- #13 Left side plays as penalty area NOT OB / Past green by homes is OB
- #14 Far left by homes is OB
- #15 OB left
- #18 OB long, past green

No drop areas on Par 3's / Free drop from any flower beds / No other local rules

Scoring procedure

- Prior to the tournament, you all should download the Golf Genius mobile app on your smart phones. Just search for Golf Genius (it's free)
- On tournament day, you will be given a Golf Genius card prior to teeing off.
 - One side of the card will be your Division, Tee Time, and a Golf Genius ID (GGID)
 - On the Other side of the card will be these instructions:

Pick one player in your group to enter scores in the Golf Genius app by logging in with the GGID. Others in foursome can use GGID to see leaderboard but only 1 should do the LIVE scoring. Each player keeps score on their scorecard for the group. After the round, fill out the white card, verify the scores and sign the white card.

Turn in the white card to the TD (who will verify and/or post scores in Golf Genius).

Covid protocols as needed. Masks are required for entrance into the clubhouse.

Bloomington GC – Saturday, May 1, 2021

Player – Blue Tees Trevino – White Tees



Closest to the pin: Player - 9 & 13 Trevino – 6 & 16

- They have rakes in the bunkers and pins can be pulled.
- Balls on wood chips must be played no free drop.
- Drop area to be used on 11.
- Out of bounds is clearly marked left side (10, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18).
- The course has three “free relief” wildflower areas: on #7 (left), on #12 (right), and #15 (left near green).
- No local rules are in effect.

Scoring procedure
