

Rules Sheet – NIMAGA PLAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP

Highlands of Elgin - Saturday & Sunday October 9th & 10th 2021

NIMAGA Hybrid Tees (Gold except 6, 7, 11 & 12 are Silver) Tees marked w/ flags

Carts & Range Balls Included



Closest to the pin Saturday: Low - 7 & 17 / High - 4 & 15 CTTP Sunday : All - 7 & 15

Rake and place in all bunkers.

Fescue/long grass may be played as a Penalty Area. You may play your ball as it lies if found or take a 1 stroke penalty and drop near where it entered the Penalty Area, not where you think it ended up. You may play as a Penalty Area even if you find your ball.

There are multiple holes where there is fescue in front of and around trees. The entire area is to be played as a penalty area, not as a lost ball or OB. If you can't find your ball, see above.

This affects holes: 5 (left), 6 (left), 9 (right), & 11 (right).

Fences on 1, 13, & 16 are OB

May use drop areas on 4 & 11 NOT on 15

NEW SCORING PROCEDURE

Prior to the tournament, please download the Golf Genius mobile app on your smart phones. Just search for Golf Genius (it's free)

On tournament day, you will be given a Golf Genius scorecard prior to teeing off.

- One side of the card will be your official scorecard. Use this to keep score according to the instructions printed on the back of the scorecard.
- The GGID is also printed on the scorecard.
- Pick one player in your group to enter scores in the Golf Genius app by logging in with the GGID. Others in foursome can use GGID to see leaderboard but only 1 should do the LIVE scoring.
 - Each player keeps score on their scorecard for the group.
 - After the round, verify the scores and sign the scorecard.
 - Turn in the scorecard to the TD (who will verify and/or post scores in Golf Genius).

Covid protocols as needed. Masks may be required for entrance into the clubhouse.
