Closest to the Pin Holes: 4th and 17th

Perimeter of all courses (wooded areas) will be played as a penalty area.

All fescue is cut down and will be played as rough. Ball can be played as is. If unplayable in these areas, then a one stroke penalty.

Lost ball applies except in fescue and perimeter.

Lift, smooth, place in bunkers (if a rake is present, you can use it to smooth).

Lift, clean and place through the green (everywhere).

No local rules are in effect.

Scoring will be done in the Main Clubhouse basement.

Covid protocols as needed. Masks may be required for entrance into the clubhouse.

Closest to the Pin Holes: 4th and 14th

Fescue Grass is to be played as a penalty area.

A drop area marked by RED FLAGS on #10 by the ravine in front of green. If your ball is lost please use drop area to maintain pace of play.

Free relief from the enclosed cart path by #10 green (including the actual fence restricting swing) no closer to the hole.

Out of Bounds is left boundary fence on #1 and behind green on 18.

Lift, smooth, place in bunkers (if a rake is present, you can use it to smooth).

Lift, clean and place through the green (everywhere).

No local rules are in effect.

Scoring will be done in the Main Clubhouse basement.

Covid protocols as needed. Masks may be required for entrance into the clubhouse.
