Klein Creek GC - Tuesday, May 17th 2022

Low - White Tees / High - Hybrid Tees

White -1,4,5,6,8,10,12,17 Gray - 2,3,7,9,11,13,14,15,16,18

Closest to the pin: Low - 8 & 17 High- 4 & 14

On holes 8 & 14, you may use the red tee box as a drop area if you hit it in the water.

There are some bunkers that have been converted into Waste Areas & some that are being transitioned to grass. The difference between the waste areas and bunkers is easily identifiable. The waste areas have brown sand/stone and the bunkers are white sand. The areas being converted to grass are also easily identifiable as they have a lot of sand mixed in with grass.

Lift, Clean, Rake & Place in all bunkers (White Sand) NOT in Waste Areas

Waste areas are to be played as General Area. You can ground your club or take practice swings. There are no rakes. You CAN NOT lift, clean and place in Waste Area.

Any areas being converted from Bunkers to grass, can be played as GUR (Ground Under Repair). Some are marked as such with a white line around them, and some are not. You can play it as it lies, or find your nearest point of relief and drop within one club length, no closer to the hole.

All flower beds are to be played as GUR. You MUST take relief. No penalty.

All water to be played as a penalty area.

This course winds through a subdivision. Out-of-Bounds comes into play on most holes. Please play a provisional if you may be close to Out-of-Bounds to prevent slowing down play. Out-of-Bounds is well marked in most places. Fences and backyards are Out-of-Bounds. Some tree lines on the outside of the course are marked Out-of-Bounds before the tree line. If not, anything beyond the trees bordering the course is Out-of-Bounds.

NEW SCORING PROCEDURE

Prior to the tournament, please download the Golf Genius mobile app on your smart phones. Just search for Golf Genius (it's free)

On tournament day, you will be given a Golf Genius scorecard prior to teeing off.

- One side of the card will be your official scorecard. Use this to keep score according to the instructions printed on the back of the scorecard.
- The GGID is also printed on the scorecard.
- Pick one player in your group to enter scores in the Golf Genius app by logging in with the GGID. Others in foursome can use GGID to see leaderboard but only 1 should do the LIVE scoring.
 - Each player keeps score on their scorecard for the group.
 - After the round, verify the scores and sign the scorecard.
 - Turn in the scorecard to the TD (who will verify and/or post scores in Golf Genius).
