Rules Sheet – Patriot's Day Classic

SPG Green Garden CC (Gold Course)- Saturday, September 10, 2022

White Tees - 69.5 / 118 Yellow Tees - 67.3 / 115

Closest to the pin: White Tees - 3 & 16 Yellow Tees - 9 & 11

Bunkers - Lift, rake, & place (No Cleaning)

The road to the left of hole 1 is OB.

Hole 7 - Multiple brown patches (fairway only) can be played as GUR (Ground under repair) All water and any red or yellow stakes to be played as Penalty Areas (PA).

All long grass, fescue, and marshy areas may be played as a PA. Play your ball as it lies with no penalty. <u>OR</u> you may take relief based on where your ball crossed into the PA, not where it may have or did end up (1 stroke penalty).

All white stakes are Out of Bounds (OB).

There is a fence surrounding the course that borders holes 4-8, and 11. If your ball goes past the fescue, long grass, or marshy area and goes over or past the fence, it is OB.

There is a maintenance area & silo between the end of the front 9 and beginning of the back 9. Anything inside the fenced area is OB.

Any shot that goes OB, must be replayed (1 stroke penalty). If you are unsure if your ball went OB in any of these situations, hit a provisional before heading to your ball to keep pace of play.

PACE OF PLAY SHOULD NOT EXCEED 4:30.

Play ready golf, player should proceed to their ball and if safe to do so, play their next shot regardless if they have "Honors" – Pace of Play can be significantly improved if all players consistently abide by this admonition. There is no need to wait if you can hit your shot safely.

Time limit for searching for ball is Three Minutes.

Players are encouraged to play their shot (Within 40 seconds) of reaching the location of their ball.

Local Rules are not used in NIMAGA Events, except those noted above
Submit official scorecards <u>immediately</u> after your round
Cart is Included

NEW SCORING PROCEDURE

Prior to the tournament, please download the Golf Genius mobile app on your smart phones. Just search for Golf Genius (it's free)

On tournament day, you will be given a Golf Genius scorecard prior to teeing off.

- One side of the card will be your official scorecard. Use this to keep score according to the instructions printed on the back of the scorecard.
- The GGID is also printed on the scorecard.
- Pick one player in your group to enter scores in the Golf Genius app by logging in with the GGID. Others in foursome can use GGID to see leaderboard but only 1 should do the LIVE scoring.
 - Each player keeps score on their scorecard for the group.
 - After the round, verify the scores and sign the scorecard.
 - Turn in the scorecard to the TD (who will verify and/or post scores in Golf Genius).
