

Rules Sheet – September Midweek

Deerfield GC – Wednesday, September 21, 2022

Gold Tees – 71.6 / 130 Blue Tees – 69.5 / 125 Silver Tees – 67.5 / 120

Closest to the pin: Low 8 & 13 – High 3 & 16 Bunkers

- Lift, rake, & place (**No Cleaning**).

Do not use drop areas.

Out of Bounds is prevalent throughout the course marked by the fence line and white stakes on holes #1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 15, 17 and 18. Play provisional ball to maintain proper pace of play!

The wooded area on left side of #10 will be played as a lateral hazard for pace of play.

All long fescue grass (not wooded area) will be played as a red stake whether it is marked or not. If a hazard is not clearly marked or staked play as a penalty area.

A scorecard playoff will be in place for this tournament due to course unavailability in late afternoon.

PACE OF PLAY SHOULD NOT EXCEED 4:30.

Play ready golf, player should proceed to their ball and if safe to do so, play their next shot regardless if they have “Honors” – Pace of Play can be **significantly improved** if all players consistently abide by this admonition. There is no need to wait if you can hit your shot safely.

Time limit for searching for ball is **Three Minutes**.

Players are encouraged to play their shot (**Within 40 seconds**) of reaching the location of their ball.

Local Rules are not used in NIMAGA Events, except those noted above

Submit official scorecards immediately after your round

Cart is Not Included (Cost \$10)

NEW SCORING PROCEDURE

Prior to the tournament, please download the Golf Genius mobile app on your smart phones. Just search for Golf Genius (it's free)

On tournament day, you will be given a Golf Genius scorecard prior to teeing off.

- One side of the card will be your official scorecard. Use this to keep score according to the instructions printed on the back of the scorecard.
- The GGID is also printed on the scorecard.
- Pick one player in your group to enter scores in the Golf Genius app by logging in with the GGID. Others in foursome can use GGID to see leaderboard but only 1 should do the LIVE scoring.
 - Each player keeps score on their scorecard for the group.
 - After the round, verify the scores and sign the scorecard.
 - Turn in the scorecard to the TD (who will verify and/or post scores in Golf Genius).

**Two Man Scramble registration closes Friday, September 23.
You must register on-line.**

If you do not have a partner NIMAGA will pair you with one.
