Low Division - Black Tees 69.4 / 121 & White Tees 67.4 / 116

High Division - White Tees 67.4 / 116 & Silver Tees 65.3 / 111



Closest to the pin:

Low Division - Holes Valley 7 & Prairie 4

High Division - Holes Valley 7 & Prairie 4

Bunkers - Lift, rake, & place.

All hazards are marked if there is anything questionable play as a penalty area.

The fescue grass is to be played as a penalty area. If you find your ball in the Fescue Grass you can ground your club and play it as it lies if you so choose.

PACE OF PLAY SHOULD NOT EXCEED 4:00.

Play ready golf, players should proceed to their ball and if safe to do so, play their next shot regardless if they have “Honors” – Pace of Play can be **significantly improved** if all players consistently abide by this admonition. There is no need to wait if you can hit your shot safely.

Time limit for searching for ball is **Three Minutes**. Players are encouraged to play their shot (**Within 40 seconds**) of reaching the location of their ball.

Closest to the pin:

Low Division Holes South 4 & East 5

High Division Holes South 6 & East 3

Bunkers - Lift, rake, & place.

OB marked with white stakes which includes backyards and driving range.

Most penalty areas are clearly marked with red stakes. All long prairie grass and marshy areas are also penalty areas if not marked.

PACE OF PLAY SHOULD NOT EXCEED 4:20.

Play ready golf, players should proceed to their ball and if safe to do so, play their next shot regardless if they have “Honors” – Pace of Play can be **significantly improved** if all players consistently abide by this admonition. There is no need to wait if you can hit your shot safely.
