The tie-breaking procedure will determine who receives both the first place prize and the tournament plaque. On the net side of the tournament the players will receive strokes in accordance with the ranking of holes on the scorecard. The same will apply in a scorecard playoff for net. The tie breaking procedure will determine who receives both the first place prize and the tournament plaque. Playoffs will be run, if necessary, for Low Gross and Low Net only.
