2024 NIMAGA CUP

As Tom mentioned in his Presidential Message above, this year's NIMAGA Cup is in full swing.

For our newer members, the MINAGA Cup is a team concept based on the format of the Ryder Cup series. Qualifications for your division's team are based on points earned each year. The top twelve point winners will receive an invitation to compete. The top point winner from each division will be the team captain. The captains select from the players left in the pool until they have reached the limit of 4 players from anyone division. Each team will have 2 pairs from each division, and they will play against a pair from one of the other teams that are in the same division.

Our captains for this year are Tom Zmuda (Red Team), Jeff Toth (Blue Team) and Dan Montgomery (White Team).

CHANGES FOR THE 2024 NIMAGA SEASON

It is important that you spend an extra minute after completing your round to check those scorecards for accuracy before signing them and turning them in to the tournament scorer. DQs could result from inaccurate scorecards.

Every NIMAGA tournament will be a Choose Your Tees event (excluding the C&G Match Play, NIMAGA Cup and the Milwaukee Challenge).

- New in 2024, if you do not respond (or declare) your tee choice, you will default to the shorter tee. Last year, our default was the longer tees.
- So be aware of that when making your tee choices.

The tee sheet that you will receive prior to the tournament will have a slightly different format. Nothing to be alarmed about. All of the necessary information will be present.

- Refer to both the tee sheet and rules sheet for all of your tournament information.
- As always, these two pieces on information are also available on the Golf Genius tournament portals

Pace of Play (PoP) violations will be carried over into the next calendar year. Meaning that, any 2024 PoP violations that exist at the end of the season will be carried over to the start of the 2025 season.

OTHER REMINDERS

As Tom mentioned earlier, we have enjoyed great participation in our tournaments in 2024, so thanks to all of you for that. But remember to register as early as you can. At the beginning of the year, our Course Selection Committee reserved courses and had to provide player estimates. When we reach those estimates, we must contact the golf courses to see if more times are available. This may or may not happen. Your best insurance for getting into a tournament is to register early.

As Tom also mentioned, we have a lot of great courses coming up on the schedule, so be sure to enter.

Thanks to everyone for their Golf Genius participation. Our tournaments are running smoother and final results are being tallied much quicker because of all of you entering scores during your tournament play. Keep up the great job.

HOLE-IN-ONE POT

The Hole-In-One pot continues to grow.

We are now at \$1,067.00 (as of May 15th).

The NIMAGA Hole-In-One is a cash pot that is collected from participating NIMAGA members (\$1 per entry) at each NIMAGA sanctioned event (excluding the C&GMPT and Milwaukee Challenge). If a NIMAGA member gets a hole-in-one in any sanctioned NIMAGA events and has paid into the Hole-In-One Pot for that event, prior to teeing off on the first hole, he will be paid a portion of the pot.

Hole-in-One entry information is always present on the tee sheet that is sent to all tournament players.
