

NIMAGA Hole-In-One (email - HoleInOne@nimaga.org)

The NIMAGA Hole-In-One is a cash pot that is collected from participating NIMAGA members (\$1 per event) at each NIMAGA sanctioned event. If a NIMAGA member gets a hole-in-one in any sanctioned NIMAGA event and has paid into the Hole-In-One Pot for that event, prior to teeing off on the first hole, he will be paid a portion of the pot. Entry into the Hole-in-One Pot is voluntary.

How to Get into the Hole-In-One POT:

- 1. Must be a NIMAGA Member
- 2. Must be a NIMAGA Sanctioned Tournament (Match Play & Milwaukee Challenge are Excluded)
- 3. All entries are part of the same POT, no matter which division or course the member is playing
- 4. Must Pay \$1 to the Hole-In-One POT prior to teeing off on your first hole of each event
 - Payments can be made in advance via VENMO to @Shawn-Pipes (Last 4 0164) (preferred method...)
 - \$ will be transferred monthly to NIMAGA Treasurer for accounting purposes
 - You are only eligible to win in the event you have paid entry into. Entry at a prior tournament
 doesn't give you a chance to WIN in the CURRENT or a FUTURE event.

How the NIMAGA Hole-In-One POT will be FUNDED.

- Members pay \$1 towards the Hole-In-One POT per 18 Holes TOURNAMENT (2 Day Events are \$1 per Day).
- 2. Each entry is added to a running POT total
- 3. A spreadsheet will be maintained for all Hole-In-One Participants and POT total per EVENT

How the NIMAGA Hole-In-One POT will be PAID OUT for Hole-In-Ones

- 1. Entire POT will never be paid out so that there is ALWAYS a POT to WIN
- 2. Payout will be 75% of POT with Minimum or \$100 up to \$3,500 MAX for a Hole-In-One
- 3. Multiple Hole-In-One's will split POT payout EVENLY
- 4. Hole-In-One **POT Payout** will be Communicated prior to each EVENT.
- 5. Entry fees for CURRENT Event are Not included in Payout of that event. The only exception is the 1st EVENT at the START of Hole-In-One POT (Only April Spring Thaw 2022)

Example of how the Hole-in-One Pot Works...

April Tournament

- 20 Members pay \$1 into Hole-In-One POT
- No Hole-In-One is recorded. \$20 rolls over

May Jamboree

- Pot is worth 75% of \$20 from April, so \$100 because of Minimum payout
- 40 Members pay **\$1** into Hole-In-One POT
- One Hole-In-One Recorded by Member who paid \$1 for April but didn't pay for May Jamboree -No WINNER

Ver. 03/11/2022

• \$60 rolls over (\$20 from April + \$40 from May Jamboree)

May Midweek

- Pot for May Midweek is worth 75% of \$60, so \$100 because of Minimum payout
- 90 Members pay \$1 for May Mid-Week Hole-In-One POT
- No Hole-In-One Recorded, \$150 rolls over
- Interest in participating is growing as the Hole-In-One POT grows

June Summer Classic

- Pot for Summer Classic is 75% of \$150, so \$112.50
- 105 Members pay \$1 for Summer Classic Hole-In-One POT
- No winner, so \$255 rolls over. The POT continues to get bigger...

June Midweek

- Pot for June Midweek is 75% of \$255, so \$191.25
- Pot continues to grow throughout the season...

September Midweek

- Pot for September Midweek has grown to 75% of \$1675, so \$1256.25
- 130 Members pay \$1 for September Midweek to Hole-In-One POT
- 2 Hole-In-One's Recorded in September Midweek. One member entered the Hole-in-One Pot for the
 first time in the September Midweek. The other member had entered the Hole-in-One Pot for each
 event except the September Midweek.
- The POT Payout of \$1,256.25 goes to the member who entered for the 1st time in the September Midweek. To WIN, you have to be in the POT for the EVENT being played.
- If both had entered the Hole-in-One Pot for the September Midweek, they would then split the \$1256.25 and get \$628.12 each.
- After payout, the Hole-In-One Pot still has \$418.75 left (25% of \$1675) + \$130 from September. So \$548.75 rolls over for the next event. POT Payout for NEXT Event is 75% of \$548.75, so \$411.56

NIMAGA has an average roster of 150 members and hosts 18 tournaments... You can see how the Hole-In-One POT can grow. Over the last 5 years, we have witnessed at least 5 Hole-In-Ones in NIMAGA Tournaments, So don't think it can't happen to you! You can be the one taking home \$3,500! ③
